



Diesel Club Rules

1. The Club will be known as the Diesel Club for short and the contents of this leaflet form part of the Club Rules.
2. The Club's purpose is to raise funds to assist with the maintenance and overhaul of all diesel traction (including Diesel Locomotives and Diesel Multiple Units) permanently based on the North Norfolk Railway from time to time. Permanently based locomotives are defined as locomotives owned by the NNR or the Society and other long term resident locomotive owning groups or private individuals supportive of the NNR or Society.
3. The club is administered by the Midland & Great Northern Joint Railway Society (or the Society).
4. There is no fixed membership term; membership is renewed monthly by payment of a monthly standing order (or so deemed).
5. Membership payments are as set out in the Leaflet. Preferred monthly contributions are £5 or more.
6. Contributions from members go into a restricted 'diesel fund' which is managed by the Society. From this fund locomotive owners can apply for grant funding from the Society for maintenance, restoration and overhaul tasks, providing that they meet the charitable objectives of the Society.
7. Applications for grant funding are to be put to the NNR engineering committee for consideration, who will advise on the appropriateness of the locomotive or unit and its usefulness to the North Norfolk Railway with their recommendations being presented to the Society's Board of Trustees who will have the final say in the determination of any application.
8. In the event of a member's contribution not being received within fourteen (14) days of the due date, the Society reserves the right to cancel their membership.
9. A member may terminate their membership by giving one months' notice to the Society at its registered office.
10. In the event of a dispute between a member of the Club and the Society, the decision of the Society's Board of Trustees shall be final.
11. The Society reserves the right to amend, alter, change or vary the rules of the Club from time to time.
